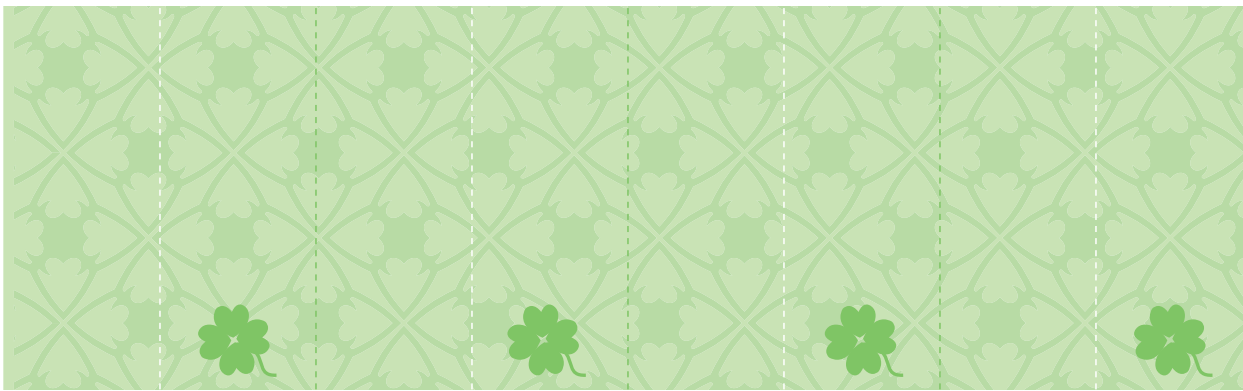


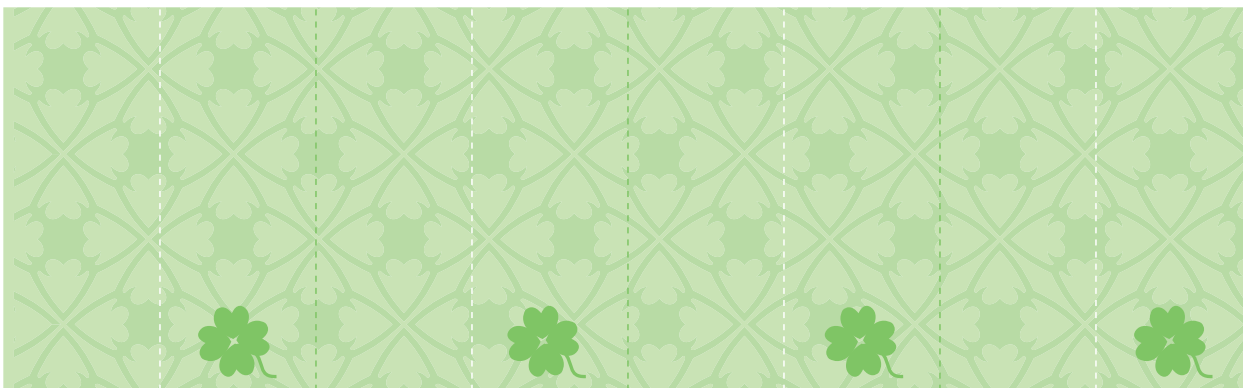
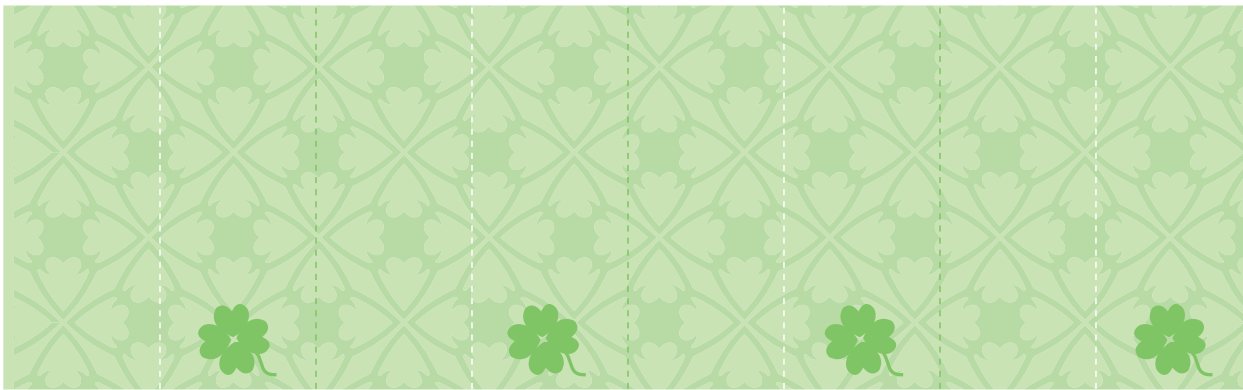
MINI SWEETS STANDS



You may use scissors, a 2.5" circle punch or even a decorative punch to cut out the top to the stand.

Make a zig zag accordion fold for the base. Open the accordion, roll a glue stick or add some double sided tape on the blank side and fold back up zig zag style. The outer sides should be stuck together with edges pointing out. Spread folds so the 'legs' looks like a plus sign from the top.

For a fancier leg you can cut out a half circle or even use a decorative punch from the outer middle of each leg, being careful not to cut too much or it will weaken the strength of the support.

Place circle top down. Add some glue to the top of the legs and center them over the bottom of the circle. Hold for a few seconds and let dry completely. Voila!

Now that you know how, you can use any pattern or paper to create an unlimited number of cute little stands.
